Restoring native plants to the landscape is an essential part of being a good steward. Thank you for sharing our passion for these amazing species and for being a pioneer in supporting native plants and the pollinators and wildlife that are critical to our ecosystems.

When installing a garden, there are some basic design ideas you may want to consider when placing plants:

DISPERSED PLANTING: By evenly dispersing each species throughout the planting area, you maximize the visual interplay between plants and take advantage of the self-seeding and natural spreading capacity of each individual plant. It may be practical to place the taller plants toward the center or back so that they are better contained within the garden.

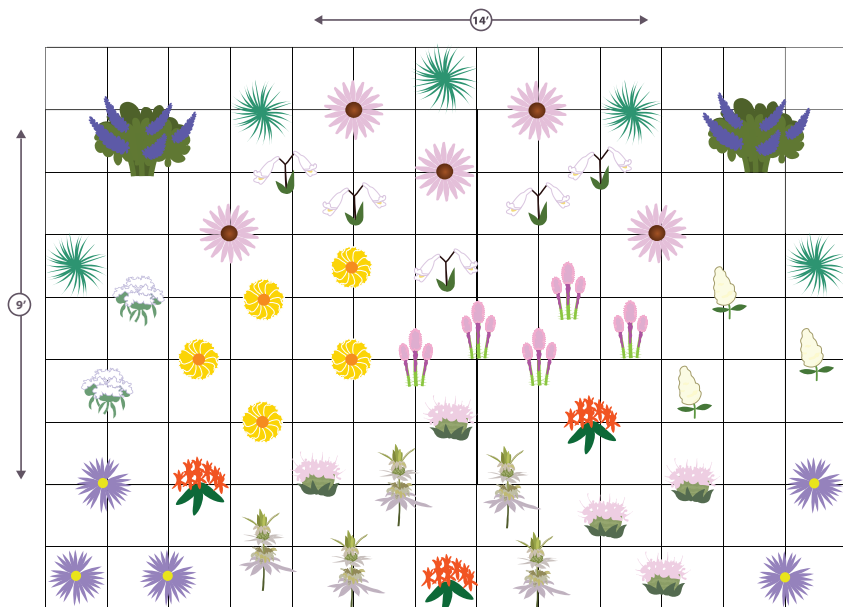
GROUP PLANTING: More structure or order can be achieved by grouping each species in its own section of the garden. Our kits can be augmented by purchasing individual plants to create larger groupings or drifts of favorite species.

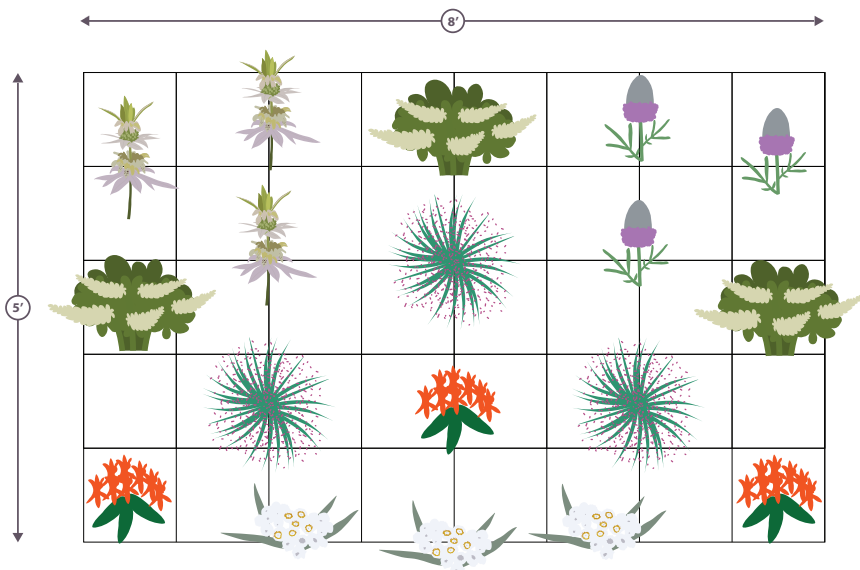

Use this tidy, compact garden design to enhance the color and diversity of your boulevard, sidewalk, or hellstrip. This layout contrasts the airy plumes of Purple Love Grass with Butterfly Weed, Cream Wild Indigo, and Pearly Everlasting for spring and summer interest. Eccentric Spotted Bee Balm and bright Purple Prairie Clover join the party later in the season, providing a striking extension of blooms in your new, wild boulevard.

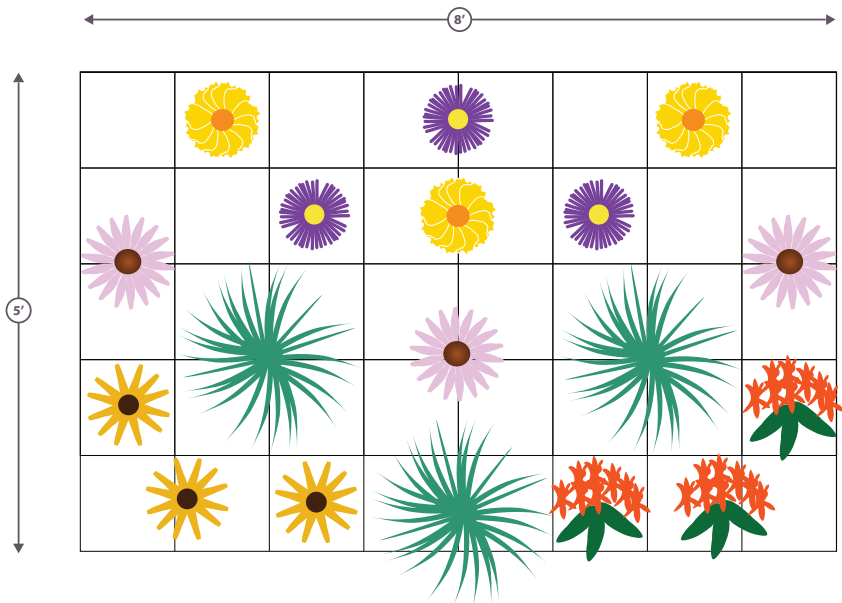

18 PLANTS | 5 Flowers, 1 Grass | Covers 40 - 50 sq ft.

-  Butterfly Weed (3)
-  Orange Coneflower (3)
-  Lance-leaf Coreopsis (3)
-  New England Aster (3)
-  Pale Purple Coneflower (3)
-  Little Bluestem (3)

With a range of colors that extend throughout the growing season, this kit neatly arranges pollinator favorites like bright Butterfly Weed, sunny Coreopsis, and lovely Coneflower around structural tufts of Little Bluestem. Orange Coneflower pairs well with the rich purple of autumn Asters, drawing eager bees and butterflies as the other flowers begin to fade.
