WHAT IS A NATIVE PLANT?

We define a native plant as one indigenous to the area prior to European settlement; a species that co-evolved with the flora, fauna, and regional conditions. A native plant has not been cultivated for characteristics such as flower shape and size, leaf color, or growing height. Such cultivar or "nativar" varieties are common in the horticultural trade.

A native plant is not naturalized or introduced. There are many plants that have entered the American landscape (either by accident or intentional) and thrived, like Queen Anne's Lace and Dame's Rocket. These naturalized plants may be called a "wildflower" by some, but they displace the native species that support our ecosystems. Some introduced plants are aggressive and invasive, like Garlic

Mustard, Purple Loosestrife, and Multi-flora Rose. These are known to wreak havoc on our native plant populations.

Native plants are foundational to our ecosystems, supplying food and habitat for local wildlife. Their presence maintains soil health, filters water, cleans the air, and supports biodiversity.

In addition to their ecological benefits, native plants are often better suited to the local climate and soil conditions, which means they require less resources to thrive. This aptitude makes them a sustainable choice for gardening, landscaping, and creating low-maintenance green spaces.

STARTING FROM SEED

The seeds of many native plants have dormancy mechanisms that protect them from germinating before killing frosts or in times of drought. In the wild, seeds lie dormant until the proper conditions for growth occur.

The successful native plant gardener must become familiar with several simple pre-sowing seed treatment methods to stimulate quicker, more consistent germination.



Our seed germination codes were developed to help you successfully grow the seed we sell. Find the germination code(s) for each of our 700+ species within this catalog, on our website, and directly on each seed packet.

GROWING TIP! PLANT NO DEEPER THAN THE WIDTH OF THE SEED

GERMINATION CODES

A No pre-treatment necessary. Seeds germinate after sowing in a warm location.

B Hot water treatment: Bring water to a boil; remove from heat. Pour over seed and allow the seed to soak for 24 hours at room temp prior to planting or starting artificial stratification.

C (#) Seeds germinate after experiencing a winter season or after a period of artificial cold, moist stratification. Sow seeds outdoors in the fall to over-winter naturally and see germination the following spring, or artificially stratify seeds for the number of days in the parentheses. For more detailed instructions on artificial stratification, go to prairiemoon.com and type GERMINATION into the search bar.

D Seeds are very small or need light to naturally break dormancy and germinate. Surface sow.

E Seeds need a warm, moist period (summer) followed by a cold, moist period (winter). Sow seeds outdoors in spring and expect germination the following spring, one full year later. To artificially mimic this stratification process, mix seeds with damp sand, place in a labeled, sealed plastic bag and store in warm (about 80°F) location for 60–90 days. Then place in the refrigerator (33–38°F) for another 60–90 days before sowing.

F Seeds have double dormancy and need a cold, moist period (winter) followed by a warm, moist period (summer) followed by a 2nd cold, moist period. Sow seeds outdoors in the fall and expect germination after 2 years. To artificially mimic this stratification process, follow instructions for code C for 60-90 days, then store a in warm (70 to 80°F) place for 60-90 days, followed by a 2nd cold, moist period for 60-90 days.

G Seeds germinate most successfully in cool soil. Sow seeds in late fall (after hard frost) or early spring.

H Seeds need scarification: To scarify, lightly rub the seed between two sheets of sandpaper before artificial stratification.

I Legume: Rhizobium Inoculum may be added. Most legume species harbor beneficial soil bacteria called Rhizobium (plural rhizobia) in nodules on their roots. These rhizobia aid in the fixation of atmospheric nitrogen and improve long-term health of native plant communities. Rhizobia are naturally occurring in most soils and additional amendment is usually not needed. However, it may be necessary in low fertility soils. Genus-specific Rhizobium strains are available at prairiemoon.com/inoculum

GERMINATION CODE C: NATURAL STRATIFICATION



OUTDOOR SOWING: To naturally stratify seed, surface sow outdoors late fall through winter on a bare (weed-free), compact site and allow seed to overwinter. If you are new to perennial seed starting, this would be the preferred method.

GERMINATION CODE C: ARTIFICIAL STRATIFICATION

SAND METHOD: SUITED FOR PLANTING IN ROWS



Place stratification sand into a bowl. Use ~1/3 cup of fine sand to 1/8 oz seed. Add water: 1 to 2 teaspoons per 1/3 cup of sand.



Mix only enough water to allow sand to form into a ball. Add your seed to the stratification sand and mix together. Our package label will indicate the suggested number of days for artificial stratification i.e. C (60) = 60 days of cold, moist conditions needed.



Refrigerate the seed mixture in a sealed plastic bag marked with start and finish dates. Check periodically so that the mixture does not dry out. If premature sprouting occurs, plant into containers and continue to grow them indoors until spring. Once cold, moist stratification is complete, sow the seed into rows outdoors when the threat of freezing temps has passed.

STORAGE TIP! STORE SEED IN A COOL, DRY PLACE BEFORE STARTING PRE-TREATMENT

COFFEE FILTER METHOD: SUITED FOR CELLS OR CONTAINERS



Using your germination code, calculate the date to start cold, moist stratification. Rinse or complete a short soak. Pour into a coffee filter, paper towel, or fine screen to drain.



Arrange seed in a single layer and allow all excess water to drain off. Fold seed loosely into the coffee filter or paper towel to allow for weekly spot checks. The seed and paper should be damp but not wet.



Add a dry paper towel to your labeled resealable bag to help to maintain even moisture while pulling excessive moisture away. Do not allow the stratification medium to completely dry out or stay soggy. Place the sealed bag in your refrigerator (not freezer) and monitor weekly, or as needed, until it is time to remove for sowing. Replace the filter or paper often to avoid mold; repeat from Step 1. Once seed has completed the recommended stratification period, or if excessive early sprouting occurs, plant immediately.

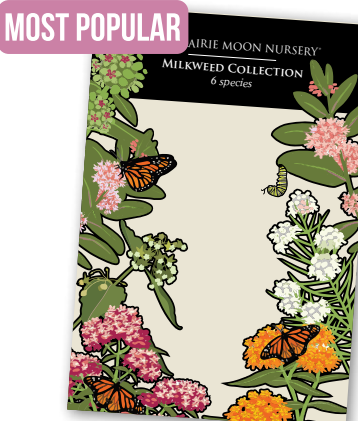

SITE PREP & SEEDING

Preparing a site is the crucial first step for native plantings. There are many methods, but the goal is to eliminate as many generations of weedy growth as possible. Most sites require at least 1 full growing season, spring through fall, to be ready for seed. After site prep is complete, sow your seed any time between late-fall and early-spring.

YEAR 1 • MOWING

Keep the site trimmed or mowed at ~6" throughout the first growing season. This controls any remaining weeds while promoting strong root development in the slower-growing perennial natives.

YEAR 2 • PIONEER FLUSH

Stop mowing or trimming at this point. Most of the plants will be growing robust green foliage in year 2. A few native species are expected to bloom this growing season, like Black-Eyed Susan and Partridge Pea. Species that are quick to establish are called the pioneer species.

YEAR 3+ • PLANT DIVERSITY

As time goes on, long-lived perennial natives will take up more space and slowly replace the pioneer flush with greater diversity and complexity. Continued site maintenance may include spot-weeding and either renewal burns or cutting.

HOST PLANTS

Host plants are essential for supporting the larval stage of beneficial insects and pollinators. Early spring is a great time to plant Eco-Grass, when it has the advantage of early-season soil moisture.

Eco-Grass grows in most soil conditions, thriving in all but the shadiest and wettest settings. This fescue blend establishes quickly, and will grow into a flowing carpet that can either be mowed or unmowed.

The relatively deep root systems (4-9") enhance drought resistance by reducing water loss as they seek out deeper water reserves. Eco-Grass also yields big savings as a lawn alternative by eliminating or reducing the need for pesticides, fertilizers, and frequent watering or mowing.

When Eco-Grass reaches about 8", it begins to form seed heads and tends to flop over, which can add an attractive naturalistic flow to landscapes. Once established, it is durable under moderate foot traffic. It resists invasion by filling in well, but will not encroach on neighboring plantings.

A cool-season grass blend, Eco-Grass is best planted on a prepared site from which competing species have been removed in early fall or early spring. Seeds can be hand-broadcast or distributed with a grass-seed spreader and should be lightly raked in and then watered well for the first two months, if needed. Depending upon conditions, germination can be expected in one to two weeks.

The cool-season nature of Eco-Grass shows in its bright-green luster in late autumn, followed by browning in dormancy and an early spring green-up.
